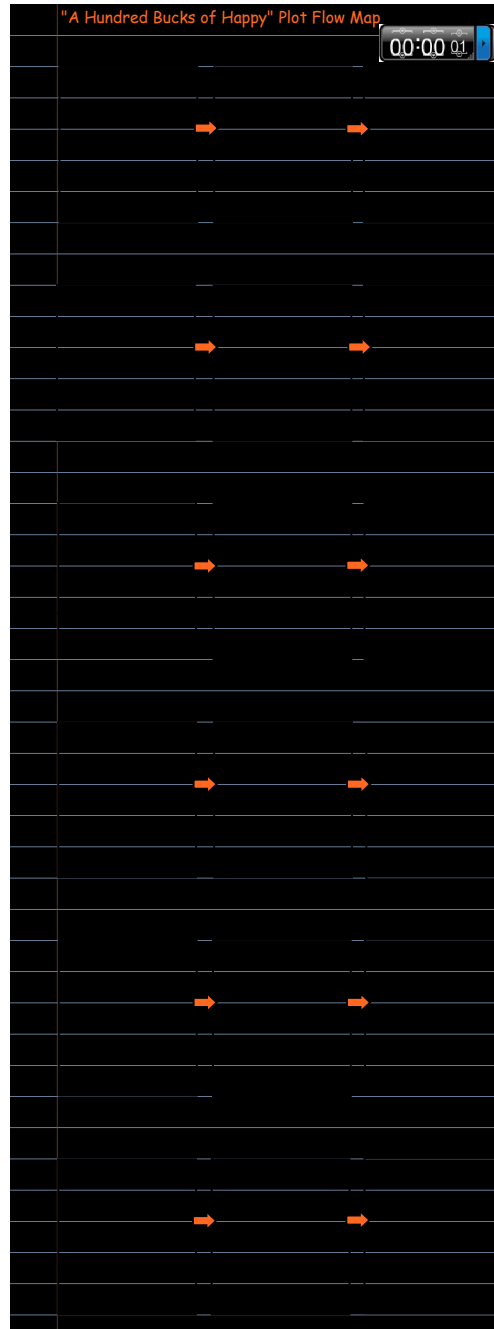


"A Hundred Bucks of Happy" Plot Flow Map

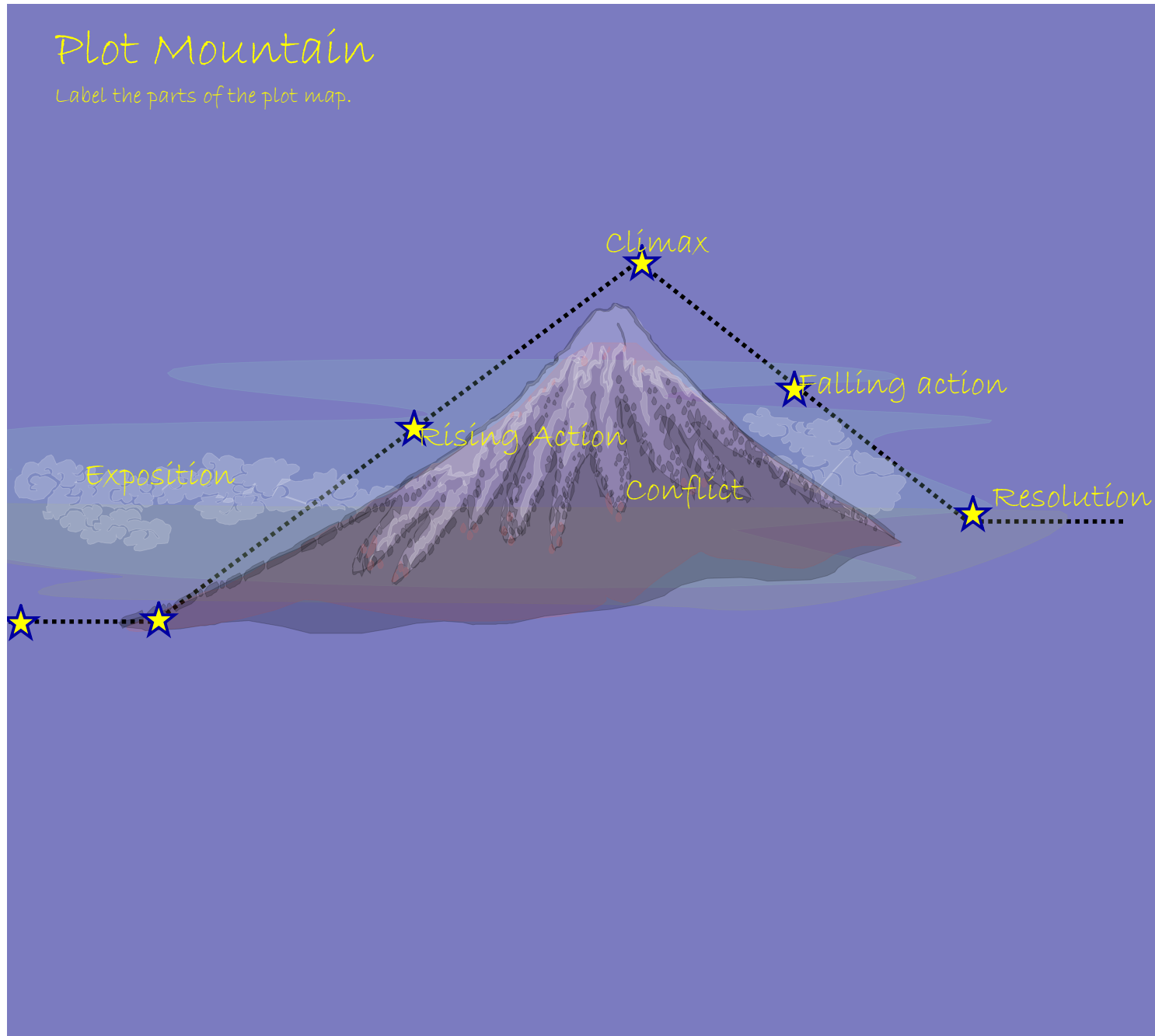
Directions:
